1851 - The family business begins when Isak Mattson builds a sawmill on the family estate at Österkvarn in Småland.

1899 - Karl's son Frans Mattson, representing the third generation of the family, joins the company and eventually takes over the management. Frans had a big vision for the future and began to invest by buying large areas of forest around Småland.



1924 - As part of the furniture manufacturing, beds and mattresses had become an important part of the business and Frans founded Mattsons Beds. From this point on, the manufacture of high quality beds and mattresses existed under its own flag. The company quickly gained a reputation for making the best beds and mattresses in Sweden.



1984 - The decision is made to relocate to the small town of Falkenberg on the west coast of Sweden, where a new factory is built. Tomas and Anders Mattson, representing the 5th generation, become increasingly involved in the business and together take over the management of the family company.



1879 - Karl Mattson takes over the family business and sees an opportunity for expansion. He opens a second sawmill in nearby Ramkvilla, while living at Höreda Mellangård.

1921 - Frans Mattson decided to expand further and set up a business fully focused on furniture making; a new company was started in Malmbäck, Småland.



1947 - Torsten and Birgitta Mattson, representing the 4th generation of the family business, continue to search for ways to refine bed and mattress production, constantly looking for better filling materials and methods to improve the already high quality of their beds and mattresses.



2018 - Oscar Mattson, who had been exposed to bed-making since childhood, had the vision to take the company to the next level. With the luxury market on the rise, Oscar saw an opportunity to further refine the products and introduce the brand through selected retail partners worldwide. As Mattsons had already been producing bespoke beds and mattresses for private homes, hotels and yachts around the world for many years, the new move seemed a natural progression. This is the beginning of Mattsons beds, with many great things to come.

Flax

Mattsons Materials

Flax fibre is one of the oldest fibre crops in the world. Flax fibre is obtained from the bast or skin of the stem of the flax plant. Flax fibre is soft, shiny, and flexible. It is stronger than cotton fibre but less elastic. The best qualities are used for linen fabrics such as damask, lace and canvas. The legendary linen suit is the symbol of breezy summer elegance because it's exceptionally cool in hot weather. The fibre absorbs and releases moisture quickly.

Bundles of fibre have the appearance of blonde hair, hence the term 'flaxen'. Coarser types are used to make twine and rope. New methods of processing flax and the rising price of cotton have led to renewed interest in the use of flax as an industrial fibre.

Wool

By using wool, you can sleep comfortably at an optimal temperature and stay dry. The wool fibre is structured in such a way that large amounts of air can be trapped between the fibres, giving it excellent insulation properties while at the same time making it flexible, elastic and resilient. In addition, wool can absorb up to 30% of its weight in water without getting wet. Just as important as growing the perfect natural fibre in a sustainable way is ensuring that it's fit for purpose and delivers optimum performance every time. By working closely with our New Zealand wool farmers, innovation partners and customers, we can offer wool that exceeds expectations and meets specific needs. And we do all this with a view to the future by anticipating future trends and adapting our methods in operations accordingly.

The ideal material to complement horsetail hair is cotton, which allows the whole body to breathe easily. The material is popular for its softness and strength. It is believed to be one of the softest materials that nature has to offer and is popular for its comfort and breathability. Mattsons soft cotton allows air to circulate around the wearer's body, keeping them dry and comfortable and ensuring a good night's sleep. As a result, you can enjoy a longer, more restful night's sleep. Everyone uses their lungs and skin to breathe, as our skin has over 7 million pores that breathe and remove toxins. To stay dry and comfortable, it is essential to sleep on a bed that breathes properly and circulates air around your body.



Horsetail hair

When it comes to making a good bed, few materials can compare with horsetail hair. Each curled strand of horsetail hair can function as a small spring, improving the function of our internal spring systems. This provides support and flexibility. When you use horsetail hair, you also choose the built-in, effective ventilation system. Horsetail hair works like a miniature respiratory tract: each strand is a hollow tube with a microscopic capillary action that removes moisture and draws in fresh air. Interestingly, their drying properties are so pronounced that soaking a strand in water and shaking it will remove the water almost instantly. Inside the Mattsons bed there are countless natural micro-springs that wick moisture and excess heat away from your body so you can enjoy a comfortable night's sleep. The absence of heat and moisture ensures that you fall asleep faster and enjoy a more restful sleep and wake up feeling completely rejuvenated. It goes without saying: Your quality of sleep will be improved with these beds.





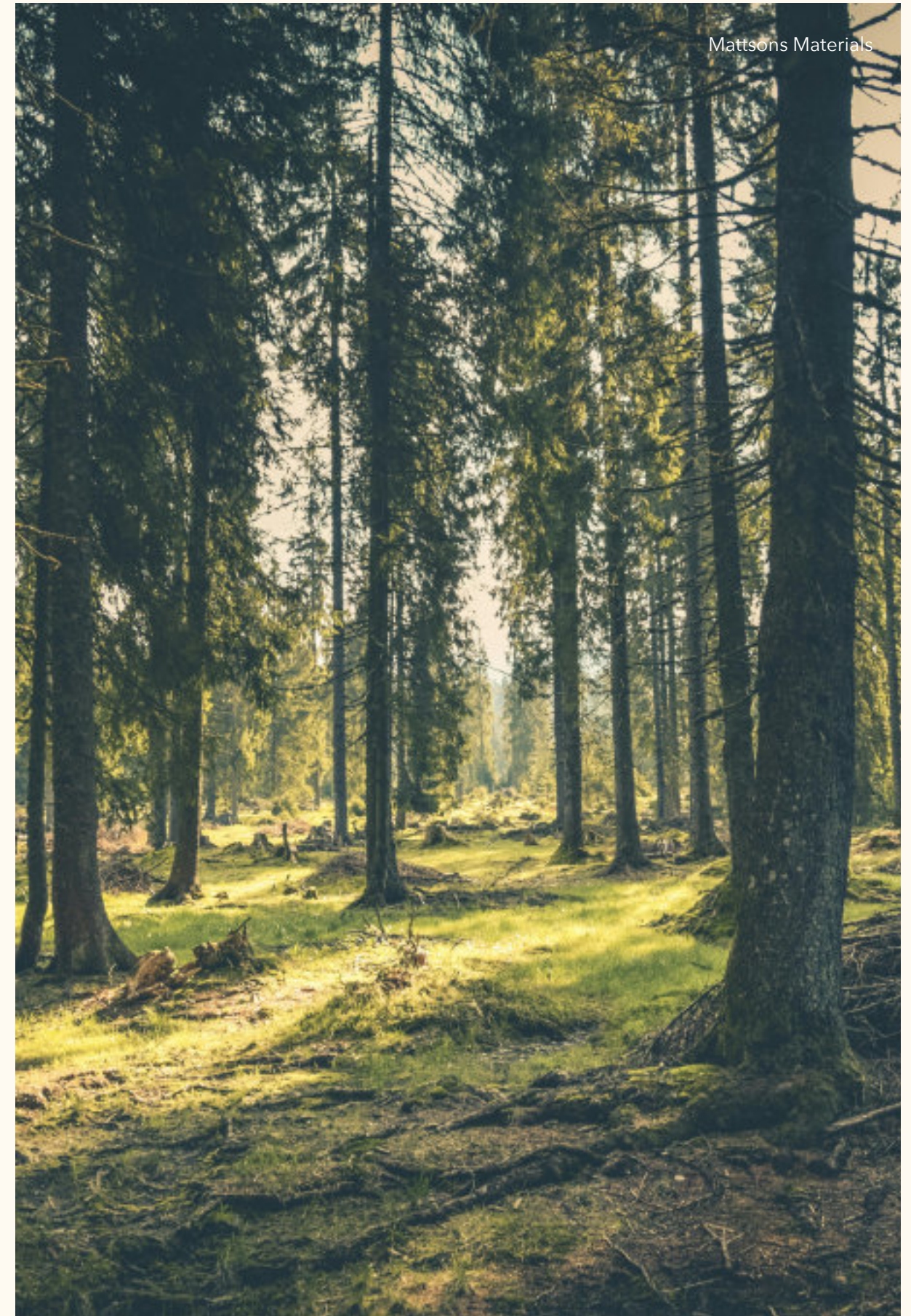
Coconut Coir Fibre

Mattsons Materials

Coconut fibre, also known as coir, comes from the inner husk of the coconut and is therefore dust mite resistant. It is also very suitable for people with allergies. The thickness of the coir is very important. If the thickness of the fibre is very small, it won't provide the necessary firmness for stability in our beds. At Mattsons Beds we use coconut material for the straight and firm edge of the mattress.

Pine

At Mattson, the use of slow-grown Swedish pine makes the bed solid and thus offers unrivalled quality. Mattson's wooden frames make every bed stable and strong, as they are made from carefully selected pine trees from the northern forests of Sweden. These trees grow slowly, which increases their robustness. We not only emphasize quality, but also environmental sustainability. We take into account the way each pine tree grows and how each forest regenerates because we love nature. In a Mattson bed, as well as in headboards, every wooden frame is FSC-certified. In simple words, they can be traced back to their origin and they are made from pine wood that is harvested using methods that maintain the forest's biodiversity, productivity, and ecological processes. All our bed frames are guaranteed for 25 years.
